David Steen – a selection of work from the acclaimed series “Heroes & Villains” - featuring b/w portraits of some of the biggest names from the film and music worlds of the 60s and 70s.

Hannah Timm - a recent photography graduate from Brighton University, Hannah's photographs explore the unique beauty of the Arctic in a series of works entitled 'Dawn of the North'.

The exhibition will also feature work by **Pete Seaward**, **Morgan Silk** and cult American photographer **Joseph Szabo**.
